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Our Mission

Pathways for Scholars is a Christ-centered cooperative of Vine and Branches Home Educators. It is our mission to partner with families to provide a challenging curriculum that enables the students to maximize their God-given potential and talents.

The Design

Pathways for Scholars is an academic co-op which meets once a week from late August through May. It is designed to enhance the educational experience for homeschooled students by providing an exciting and challenging curriculum in a group setting.

Pathways for Scholars uses an integrated curriculum learning approach, which enables students to make connections across the curricula. This rich curriculum is planned and organized by our facilitators and our academic director, and is provided for our families, so they understand what will occur throughout the semester. Our goal is to grow the students in wisdom and in godly character. In order to reach this goal, we create rigorous daily lesson plans, which we email weekly to our families. We also provide resources, lesson ideas, assignments, and project ideas to facilitate parents as they educate their children. When we meet, students are provided a thriving environment for learning, using exploration, creativity, experimentation, discovery, critical reasoning and presentation as they work along with their peers. Students from Pre-K to 12th grade are provided with several opportunities to research, create and present various projects throughout the year in front of facilitators, parents and peers.

From 5th grade through high school, we create an environment of accountability by grading the students' work.

In the Pathways for Scholars setting the students have the opportunity to benefit from academic projects that are well-suited to a group environment and learn independent study skills while developing friendships, practicing social skills, and growing in faith.
