



Spanish 1

Bienvenidos a Spanish 1.

In Spanish 1, students will gather strategies for learning the basics for Spanish speaking. The students will learn familiar greetings and learn how to respond to basic questions. Students will also learn to respond to basic requests. Students will learn present tense verb conjugations for both regular and irregular verbs, and will learn how to use these verbs in beginning conversations. The students will practice using the verbs in both written form and in classroom conversations. While learning the basics of the Spanish language, students will also begin to examine the Spanish culture.

Spanish 2

Bienvenidos a Spanish 2.

In Spanish 2, students will continue to add to their strategies for learning the Spanish language. The students will begin to have more challenging conversations in Spanish. Students will begin to use the past verb tenses; the preterit and the imperfect in written exercises and in conversations. They will work on various grammar aspects such as indirect object pronouns, direct object pronouns, demonstrative adjectives and possessive adjectives. The students will also become familiar with the future tense. The students will write in paragraphs demonstrating their knowledge of the concepts in Spanish 2. Students will grow in their ability to speak the Spanish language while learning more about Spanish culture.
